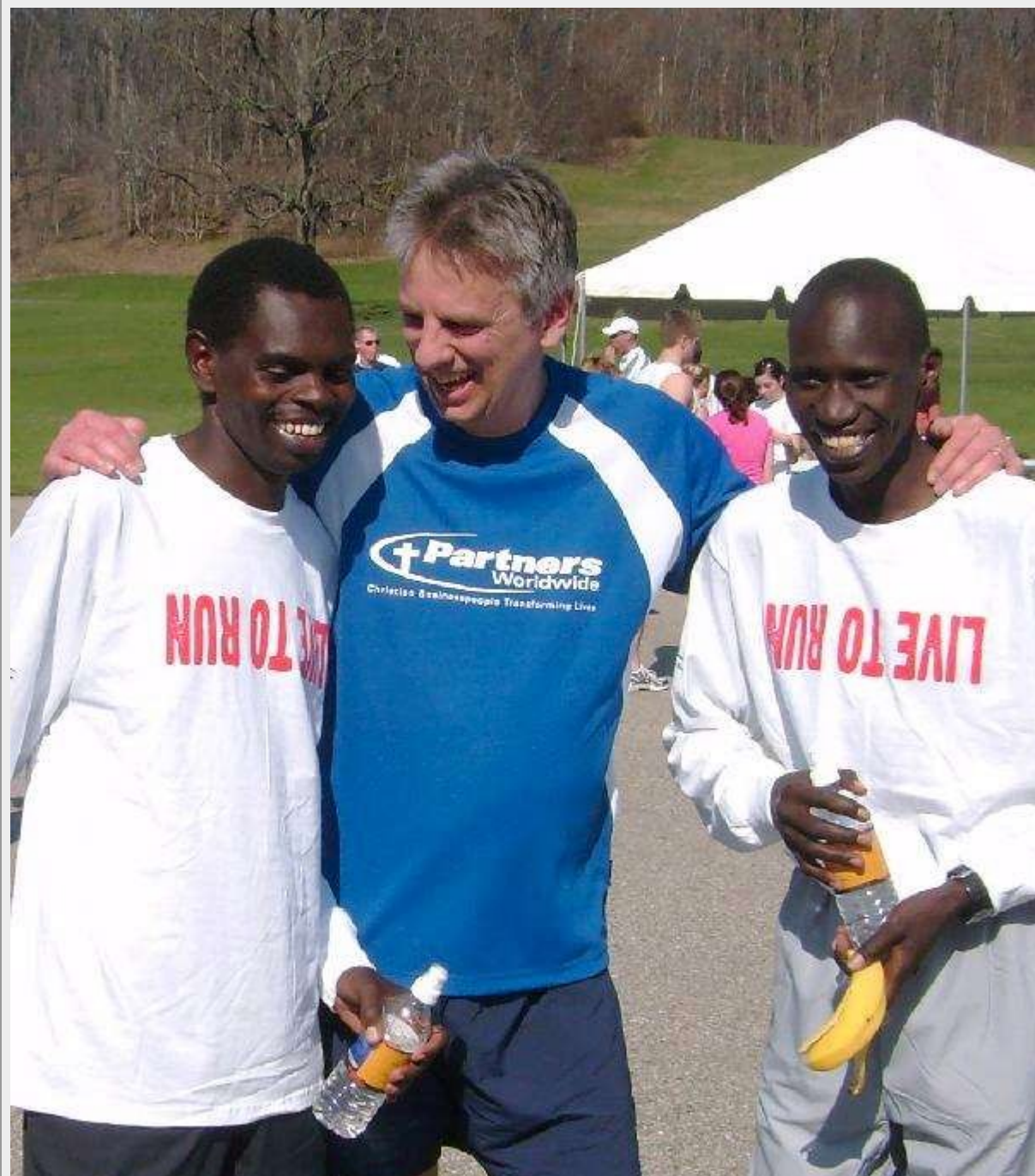
Accessing Clean Water In Nicaragua "With God's Help"
