I am just completing my first week of ministry, with a marvelous and dedicated group of volunteers from three Greensboro, NC churches, here at GSF, as it is locally known. We have had a tremendous ministry with the 110 orphans, their super-good HOSANNA PRAISE CHOIR, a fine clinic that was open to the public for three days this week and saw dozens saved through follow-up evangelism, including many Muslims, AND construction work on the Guest House, where we have poured a 15 X 50 ft. fellowship veranda adjoining the sleeping rooms and kitchen for volunteers like us who visit and help with the ministry of the orphanage throughout each year. I can't wait to have time to tell you more about what God has been doing here. I haven't the computer time available right now, but **THANK YOU SO MUCH FOR YOUR PRAYERS, SUPPORT AND ENCOURAGEMENT.**

This coming week I'll be in Kampala, where I will reconnect with the Wilson Turumanya family, at a kind of family reunion there. Then on to Hoima, Masindi and much other service to God's special saints here in Uganda.
