

**S.O.A.P. Bible Study**  
**June 22, 2008**

**S=Scripture:** Malachi 2:10-16

**O=Observations:** God's people come to him weeping and wailing because he no longer is receiving their offerings. What reasons does he give for treating them as he does? See verses 11 and 14. What command does he give them?

**A=Application:** In what ways have you been unfaithful...to God, to others, and if you are married, to your spouse? Verse 16 says 'be on your guard and don't be unfaithful.' What specific things do you need to guard in these relationships? What hope do you find in Hosea 2:19,20 and Ephesians 5:25-26; 31-32?

**P=Prayer:** Write a prayer of response.
