“God is With Us: Emmanuel”

S=Scripture: John 1:1-14

O=Observation: After carefully reading this text, answer the following questions: Look up Genesis 1:1. What similarities do you see? What does John 1:1 say about the divinity of Christ (that he is God)? Look up also John 5:18 and John 8:58. What more do you learn about how Jesus was perceived and what he claimed for himself? How did his own people receive him? (see John 1: 11). Who became “flesh” according to John 1:14? What further evidence do we have in that verse that God himself took on human flesh? What is Jesus described as being full of? Why is that important?

A=Application: How does this text help you understand again the miracle and unexpectedness of God coming in human flesh?

P=Prayer: Write out a prayer based on your meditation on this passage:
