Madison COVID-19 Survey All Site Executive Summary


324 responses across sites, with the vast majority of the responses coming from the Square site.

Age: for all sites the majority of the responses came from the 35-54 and 55-64 age range. For North and Ford sites, there was a much higher percentage in thh 35-54 range. As you would suspect, then those sites were more likely to have younger children at home. This is especially seen at the Ford site, where only 73% of respondents had children under 18 living at home with them (compared to 62% over all)

The ethnic breakdown was roughly the same across sites, with the Ford and North sites registering a slightly higher percentage from People of Color groups.




2. Which other type of activity BEST signals to you that it is time to begin gathering in-person to worship? (assume that we are following local/state guidelines)




3. As soon as we receive clearance for public gatherings from our local officials, which of the following would you prefer for our church?

Mandatory mask wearing - 30.6%


Limit the gathering size, even if more services are required - 31.2%

All of these - 49.4%






7. Would you be okay if we had to check every person's temperature as they entered the building? 324 responses
