

Madison Girls is a ministry for 2nd-5th grade girls and it is all about discipleship! Typically we meet on Wednesday evenings from 6:30-8:30 pm for worship and Bible study, followed by rotations of sports, craft, and small groups. We focus on building deep relationships through the activities and intentionally include time for girls to share highs and lows and pray for one another. Leaders are also able to have deep discipling relationships with the girls since they see them every week and oftentimes girls have the same leader from when they are in 2nd grade all the way until they are in 5th grade.

This year because of Covid restrictions, Madison Girls will look a little different. We will be meeting over Zoom each Wednesday night, along with the Cadets, from 6:30-7:30pm for Bible study and games/activities to go with the lesson. We will be studying Micah 6:8 this year and are going to take the whole year to study Bible stories about justice, mercy, and walking humbly with God.

And, in order to still be able to have deep discipleship, we are also going to meet outdoors once a month on Saturday mornings for activities, crafts, and a chance to be together in person!

Madison Girls has been around for a long time (at least 20 years) and has always been about allowing girls to build deep relationships with other girls and women at the church!
